

## <u>Across</u>

3. The first milk the doe or ewe produces after given birth to their offspring. The milk is thick and golden yellow in color and contains rich antibodies. If the newborn does not consume the milk within the first 24 hours of life, there is very little chance the animal will survive

6. A pharmaceutical product injected or fed to the animal that helps it fight off a bacterial infection

9. A goat whose birth and ancestry has been recorded by a registry association 11. To separate nursing offspring from their mothers so that they no longer receive milk

## Down

The placenta and associated membranes expelled from the uterus after parturition
A sexually mature intact male goat used for breeding

4. Inflammation of the udder usually caused by a bacterial infection

5. An excessive accumulation of gas in the rumen and reticulum, resulting in distension of the abdomen

7. The period when goats will breed naturally. This season usually begins in the fall

8. Male parent

10. A sexually-mature female goat
