**Youth Show:** \$7.00 Members - per goat, per class or  
\$9.00 Non-Member - per goat, per class.

**Open Shows:** \$10.00 Members - per goat, per class  
\$12.00 Non-Member - per goat, per class.

**Late Entry Fees:** Postmarked April 19<sup>th</sup> 2024, or later will have late fees applied. Please add \$2.00 for every goat/class/show and showman.

**Pen Fees:** The cost is \$10.00 per pen. Pens are 6X8. Pens will be marked for your convenience. No bedding is provided. Bring tarps/covers and/or barricades for baby goats as they may get out of pens. Pens will need to be cleaned out before leaving.

**Supplies:** Bermuda hay will be available for purchase.

**Food:** There will be a food vendor on site. Fast food and restaurants nearby.

**Uniforms:** All 4-H, FFA, and Grange members are required to wear proper uniforms during the youth show. Non-affiliated, Independent showman must wear blue jeans and collared shirt.

**Prospect Wether Class:** The purpose of the class is for exhibitors to show bucklings that are going to be wethers that the owner has chosen not to castrate at an early age. This class will be the first wether class judged at each show. However, they will not compete for Best Wether and Reserve Best Wether and are non-sanctioned classes.

**Master Champion:** The Master Champion competition will be held at the beginning of each full show. There must be three PGCH Does/ Bucks for each competition. If you enter your animal and then are unable to bring it, please contact the show chair immediately so they can contact other owners in the event the show may not meet the required number. Please register your MCH on the entry form.

**Health Checks:** Only healthy animals are allowed on fairgrounds. Animals with obvious signs of illness (runny noses, eyes, cough) or parasites (scratching or diarrhea) will be requested to leave. No refund on entry fees.

**NPGA Rules to Govern:** Youth and Open Shows are NPGA Sanctioned. Only animals with original registration papers or registration papers with transfers less than (90) days will be allowed to show. See the class list for more info. **Original Registration papers must be present at the show.**

**Awards:** NPGA Rosette Ribbons are awarded to all Champions for Youth and Open shows. Youth Showmanship - First place recipients will receive belt buckles. Youth show - Prizes awarded 1st - 6th place. Additional prizes will be awarded.
